Hospice Documentation Hospice providers must establish and maintain a clinical record for every individual receiving care and services. The record must be complete, promptly and accurately documented, readily accessible and systematically organized to facilitate retrieval.

### **Hospice Palliative Care Jobs, Employment in Colorado ...**

1.18 Hospice day care means health and social services provided on a regularly scheduled basis in a day care center governed by the licensed hospice to insure the overall continuum of patient care. 1.19 A hospice residential facility is an optional part of the home care or respite services provided by the hospice.

### **Hospice Nursing Documentation: Supporting Terminal Prognosis**

Once the patient is admitted to GIP the hospice team must document each day the continued need for the GIP level of care that identifies the specific symptoms being managed. The documentation should always reflect working towards a lower level of care with discharge planning evident from the first day of the GIP admission.

Hospice documentation makes up the clinical record of a patient receiving hospice services. CMS is looking for documentation that is complete, thorough, and patient-specific. As a result, hospices that have long relied on cloning and “checkbox charting” methods are facing the reality of adopting new documentation methods that satisfy regulatory requirements and enhance patient care quality.

### **HOSPICE DOCUMENTATION: PAINTING THE PICTURE OF THE ...**

Hospice documentation should always paint a clear picture of patient care throughout the benefit period. Poor documentation can expose clinicians to disciplinary action and legal scrutiny. Accurate, compliant documentation needs to be standard practice for all clinicians — but sometimes that’s easier said than done.
