With the engine cold, take off or release the pressure cap on the radiator - or on a separate tank if one is fitted. Some cars have a tap or drain plug in the bottom of the radiator - open it and the radiator should empty. If no water flows, poke a drain-plug hole gently with wire, or unscrew and remove a tap.
