NIH peer reviewers are scientists, mostly from academia. Given that they must provide objective, fair, and timely reviews free from inappropriate influences, they are fully vetted for potential conflict of interests, appropriate expertise requirements, and other requirements based on NIH peer review policies.

### NON-FEDERAL PEER REVIEW TRAVEL GUIDELINES

Peer review of grant applications at the NIH is based on the review criteria defined by the NIH (Table 1), and recent changes in NIH review procedures have made it possible to examine how the assigned reviewers evaluate the review criteria and how those evaluations are related to the overall impact score.

If reviewers choose to make NIH peer review travel reservations outside of WTS through a self-purchased ticket, reviewers will need to do the following: 1) Request pre-approval (4 to 6 weeks from the date of the meeting) from the designated Scientific Review Evaluation Activities (SREA) Sr. Program Specialist or IC SREA Administrator.

### NIH Information Quality

Despite the intended purpose of improving quality medical care, the peer review process has suffered several setbacks throughout its tenure. In the 1980s, abuse of peer review for personal economic interest led to a highly publicized multimillion-dollar verdict by the United States Supreme Court against the perpetrating physicians and hospital.

Reviewers can find process and policy resources that walk them chronologically through their review tasks, while scientific review officers can find the latest review guidelines and policy documents. Applicants can get a sense of the key elements reviewers are looking for in their grant applications.

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### Guidelines for Reviewers: Protections for ... - grants.nih.gov

NIH uses the Secure Payee Reimbursement System (SPRS) to electronically reimburse peer reviewers for honoraria and expenses from participating in peer review meetings. Reviewers must register with SPRS through the eRA Commons and maintain current address and banking information in the system to ensure timely disbursements.
